## B. Ordinance 16-O-05 - Compensation Ordinance for Township Elected Officials

A committee was formed to discuss the setting of salaries for Elected Officials for the next four year term. Trustee Alexander presented to the Board the committee's recommendation of salary adjustments. The committee recommends that the Board increase the Trustee salaries from \$1K to 2K, Highway Commissioner from \$79K to \$83K, Assessor from \$83K to \$86K, Supervisor to remain the same at 38.8K and Clerk to remain the same at \$27.5K. Mumaw went on record stating that he feels if there is an increase that it should be across the board and not for just some.

Trustee Alexander made a motion which was seconded by Trustee Talbot to approve Ordinance 16-O-05 Roll Call: Jill Talbot, Trustee-yes; Doug Alexander, Trustee-yes; Jack Mumaw, Trustee-no; Jeff Raider, Trustee-absent/excused; David Nelson, Supervisor-yes. Motion carried.

### A. Assessor's report

Tonigan reported that there have been more than 900 hearings filed and the majority was filed by letter and the County has denied Cuba Township to discuss their evidence.

Knapik reported that the Fall Festival is all set for this coming weekend. Knapik also reported that there will be cemetery maintenance of tree removal, fence repair and camera replacement beginning this week and that security has been arranged for the Halloween weekend by the Lake Co. Marks reported that brush pick up will begin on Oct 17<sup>th</sup>. Tree trimming has begun to make room for plows and the upcoming winter snow season.
